



Alfred E. Muldoon

December 22, 1950 - December 7, 2016

Alfred E. Muldoon was born on December 22, 1950 and passed away Wednesday December 7, 2016 at the age of 65.

He was a lifelong resident of Hot Springs. He performed a 3 year term of service in the U.S. Army from 1968 to 1971 serving in Vietnam in 1969-70. He was retired from the U.S. Postal Service. Alfred loved thoroughbred racing and was active in horse breeding and racing at Oaklawn Park and other midwest tracks. He was a member of the Hot Springs Showmen's Association and served on the board of governors. Alfred accepted and loved his Savior and Lord Jesus Christ.

Alfred was preceded in death by his parents, Merlyn C. and Alta Inez Muldoon; brothers, Charles Muldoon, Johnny Muldoon, Lon Robert (Lonnie) Muldoon; sister, Amata Rose Colley and nephew, Matthew Colley.

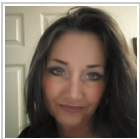

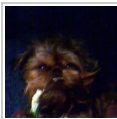
