Allen Ernest "Pete" Hemenway (1935-2020) went to be with his Savior on September 28, 2020 after a twelve-year battle with multiple myeloma.

Pete was born in Vermont and proudly enlisted in the Army after high school. He attended Vermont Tech and played varsity basketball. Pete was named one of America's Outstanding Young Men in 1966 and enjoyed a fruitful career in International construction. He traveled the world extensively and lived in Lagos, Nigeria and Windlesham England.

Pete was preceded in death by wife and high school sweetheart, Francis Roe, and his sister Norma Pollard. He is survived by his two children, Peter Hemenway (Kelli) and Stephanie Strube (David), his wife, Sue and two stepsons, Erik Daugbjerg (Danielle) and Brian Daugbjerg (Kerri).
