Arline (Weenie) Howard French, 102 a resident of Hot Springs for 64 years died November 3, 2021 in Hot Springs. She was born March 29, 1919 in Durant Mississippi to David Markham Howard and Blanche Pinson Howard. She was a graduate of Durant High school and attended Holmes Junior College before graduating from Delta State University. She was an elementary teacher for four years during World War II before marrying Dr. James H. French.
