Barbara McKennett Spindler passed from this life on Thursday, March 28, 2019, and went to be with God. She was 77 years of age.

Barbara was born April 15, 1941, spending her early years in Somer's Point, New Jersey, before graduating in 1959 from Ocean City High School. She attended college at The Presbyterian Hospital of Philadelphia, School of Nursing earning her Associates degree in 1962. In 1983, Barbara earned her Bachelor of Science degree in Health care Administration from East Texas State University.

Barbara met her eventual husband, Robert Alan Spindler, Sr., at a wedding reception and wed shortly thereafter, settling down in the Philadelphia suburb of Media, Pennsylvania. Barbara and Robert were blessed with three children: Robert Jr., Scott and Lisa.

Barbara spent her working years as a labor and delivery nurse, first in Philadelphia, then Dallas and finally, Hot Springs. Upon retirement in 2006, she turned her attention to antiques, a true passion of hers. She also spent time volunteering at her church, First Presbyterian Church in Hot Springs.
