Carl L. Lynch, 79, of Hot Springs passed away on Monday, December 8, 2014. He was born on June 23, 1935 in Hot Springs to the late Carl T. and Evelyn Rainwater Lynch. He was an active member of First Baptist Church having taught the four year old Sunday School Class, had driven the church bus, served on the Historical Committee, cooked for Wednesday night meals and Men's Breakfast and worked in the Media Ministry. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, was a retired Letter Carrier for the Postal Service. After retiring from the post office, he drove a city bus for the City of Hot Springs. He served as a Volunteer Firefighter for the Lake Hamilton Fire Department. He also loved the outdoors grilling, fishing and camping.
