



## Donald Morris Cunningham

June 28, 1938 - May 24, 2022

Donald Morris Cunningham went home to be with his LORD and Savior May 24, 2022.

Born June 28, 1938, in North Little Rock, AR, to Cecil and Mildred Cunningham, he was predeceased by his second wife, Mamie Sue Shackelford Adcock Cunningham, who died less than two weeks before; his parents; his stepfather William H. Parker; and his first wife, Masuko Kanno Cunningham.

Survivors include his son, Douglas Cunningham; his sister, Delores Clark of Tampa, FL; his brother and sister-in-law, Tom and Kuniko Cunningham of Pomfret, MD; brother and sister-in-law Jeff and Mary Jo Parker of Austin, AR; nieces and nephews: Scott Clark of Pilot Point, TX; Christi Ann Stilley of Tampa, FL; Christopher and Ashley Cunningham of Beavercreek, Ohio (for whom he performed their marriage ceremony); his sons/daughters-in-law, Darrin and Beth Adcock, and Dana and Shane Simanton.

Rev. Don was a 1959 graduate of Hot Springs High School and served 20 years in the United States Air Force as a helicopter maintenance professional. He then attended and received two associate degrees from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, TX. He was first and foremost a Baptist minister of the Gospel and believer in JESUS CHRIST. He pastored a

church in Black Hills, SD, before moving back to his hometown of Hot Springs, where he pastored Emmanuel Baptist Church for some 10 years before his retirement.

While he was serving in the Vietnam War, he was exposed to Agent Orange which caused him ill health for years. He received a number of medical procedures with the Veterans Administration.
