Eudox Patterson, 81, of Hot Springs passed away June 11, 2023. He was born May 3, 1942 in Fort Smith, AR to the late James and Blanche Patterson.

Eudox was a local Lawyer for over 50 years, served in the United States Army, a member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church, The Elks Lodge, and part of the Band of Brothers. He graduated from Fort Smith High School in 1960, earned his Bachelor of Science and Business Administration degree in 1965 and Juris Doctor Law degree in 1970, both from The University of Arkansas Fayetteville. 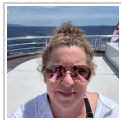
