Eugene Edward Martin, 75, of Bonnerdale died Monday, January 20, 2014 in Texas.

Born March 4, 1938 at Iowa City, Iowa to Joseph & Marjorie Wynkoop Martin. He retired from the United States Marine Corps in 1975 with 20 years of service to his country and received the Purple Heart on two separate occasions for wounds received in combat in Vietnam. After retiring from the Marine Corps he was a diesel mechanic for Ford Motor Company in San Diego, California until retiring to Bonnerdale. He was predeceased by his parents; his first wife, Mary L. Martin; three brothers, Joseph A. Martin, Jr., John A. Martin and James F. Martin, Sr. and two sisters, Joan Hotz and Jane Alice Commander.
