Frank Lee Qualls, age 94, passed away on March 17, 2025. Born on October 1, 1930, to Eddie Lee and Lillie Qualls in Clarksville, Arkansas, he was next to the youngest of 7 children.

Frank began repairing bicycles and other odd jobs to help his family survive the harsh times of the 1940's after he lost his father when he was only 12.

In high school he began working at Laster's Drug Store and became interested in medicine. Upon graduating from the College of the Ozarks, he attended medical school and obtained a Doctor of Pharmacy degree.

Frank was a gifted singer who also sang on the local radio and performed in many community theater musicals after moving to Camden, Arkansas. His talent and love of music was passed on to his children and grandchildren who are all involved in music in some form whether professionally or as a hobby.

The latter part of Frank's 50 years as a pharmacist, landed him in Hot Springs, Arkansas where he met and married Sue, a kind and caring woman whom he adored. They enjoyed retirement together and were happily married until her passing.

Frank is preceded in death by his wife, Johnnie Sue Qualls, Stepdaughter Wanda (John) Dugan, and wife Wilma Qualls.
