Fred V. Burrough, 84, of Hot Springs passed away August 3, 2021. He was born on April 30, 1937 in Hot Springs to the late Raleigh and Evelyn (Davis) Burrough. Fred was an Army veteran and served during the Korean War. He had a long career as an animal trainer in Hot Springs, Texas and California. He trained animals for the I.Q. Zoo, Animal Wonderland, Seven Seas, Japanese Village and Hannah-Barberra Marine World (Sea World). Fred was also a realtor and worked for several brokers over the years, where he made many lasting friendships.

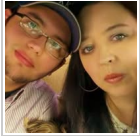
