Jason Daniel Shelor, 34, of Hot Springs passed away on Friday, May 19, 2017. He was born on January 25, 1983 in Victorville, California. Jason was active in community affairs, especially those dealing with veterans. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force and was proud of the years that he served on the Air Force Honor Guard at Arlington National Cemetery. While on the honor guard he served on President George W. Bush's inauguration and on the detail that served in California on President Ronald Reagan's funeral. On several occasions he was selected as the outstanding member of the honor guard. As a teenager, he was active in the Boy Scouts and earned the distinction of "Eagle Scout". He attended Piney Baptist Church.

Jason will be remembered for his sense of humor and his cheerful spirit. He was always willing to help others especially veterans.

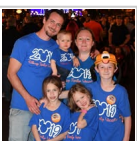
