Early in her life Elaine worked as a pre-school teacher. She also was very active in helping others and assisted in founding the Martin Luther King Youth House for troubled teens in the ghetto of Cleveland.

In the early 70's, Elaine married Bob Berry and they moved to Hot Springs. In 1984, they founded Potter's Clay which continues to minister to women in crisis in the Hot Spring area. Elaine was a devout Christian with a servant's heart and led many people to know her Lord Jesus Christ.

She is predeceased by both her parents, her husband (Bob Berry), her sister (Marilyn Petrie), her niece (Sandy Dukes), and her step-daughter (Martha Canty).

Survivors include her only daughter Janis Moore (Bob); three sons: David (Marty) Kastner, Dale (Cheryl) Kastner , and Gary (Shelley) Kastner; former husband, Glenn Kastner; and son-in-law, Tom Canty. She was blessed with twelve grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.
