He came from somewhere around Amarillo, where my grandmother's sister the Bouquots in Tampa started a museum. Joe was in business and helpful to my mom Velma Magoon's business in Hot Springs and Dallas Texas. This was at a time when the TV show Dallas was on and J R Ewing was a role model. Joe was as big and tough as any man I knew. I knew him when he on the trailer park and the Healy Motel, and when he was fire chief at the Piney Fire Department. He partnered with and took care of a handicapped man named Homer. He was also a mentor to a young man I knew and helped him become and grow into a man and a firefighter. When I came back from graduating college and started my career with the state health department, I found Joe at the public health and safety meeting for the county advocating for cable TV service to be ran outside the city limits so that the County residents could get the news of a tornado coming without the TV blinking out. Some people would call him a Small Town Hero, to this hillbilly boy he was a Superman.*

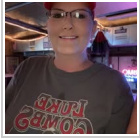
