Julius (Sunny) Peter-Herman Breckling, 83, of Hot Springs passed away Monday, October 22, 2012. He was born March 7, 1929 to the late Martha Weigle Breckling and Julius Breckling Sr. in Hot Springs.

Julius graduated from Lakeside High School and Oklahoma State University in 1951. He was the Parks and Recreation Director in Little Rock. When he retired the city dedicated River Front Park to him in honor of the work he did on the Parks and Zoo. Then he went on to finish his dream to finish "Two Rivers Park Bridge" on July 8, 2011.
