



## Marcia Ann Hudson

August 10, 1953 - June 4, 2015

Marcia Ann Moore Hudson, 61, died June 4, 2015 after a 20-month challenge from brain cancer. She handled her diagnosis the same way she lived the rest of her life, with grace, dignity, humor, courage and her Christian faith.

Born August 10, 1953 at Tinker Air Force Base, Oklahoma to Bill and Lillian Pebworth Moore, Marcia attended schools in Denver until the family moved to Arkansas. She graduated from Hot Springs High School in 1971 and attended the University of Arkansas in Fayetteville.

As the owner of Mrs. Miller's Restaurant, Marcia greeted every customer and became friends with many. Together with her husband, John, she was the third generation of her family to operate the business, following her great-aunt, then her parents.

A devoted mother and grandmother, Marcia relished being a full-time "Ging Gong" to her five grandchildren after her retirement in 2006. Joy and laughter surrounded the family get-togethers. A natural teacher and confidant, Marcia shared knowledge with the children and glowed with pride in all of their many accomplishments.
