Friday the 21st of November, the world lost one of its funniest, hard-working, and loyal men. Norman B. Martin of Hot Springs, Arkansas, died as a result of complications resulting from heart surgery. He was born in Mena, Arkansas, on November 16, 1926, as the fifth child of John and Olivia Martin.

He was retired from the Navy (hospital Chief Medical Corpsman during World War II and Korean Wars) and Reynolds Metals (Jones Mill Reduction Plant).

Norman was married to Jacque Ellen Graham with whom he had four children: Lynn Sheets, Richard Martin (Meri), David Martin (Judy), and Jann Hubbard (Bruce).
