Patricia Ann Terlecki, 67, passed into the arms of her Savior early on the morning of Thursday, September 27, 2018.

Born September 4, 1951, in Hot Springs, to Lee Edward Warren and Othel Lee (Lane) Warren, she was preceded in death by her parents and two brothers, Edward Eugene Warren and Robert (Bobby) Lee Warren.

Pat is survived by her husband of 35 years, Roman C. Terlecki; son, Lee W. (Brittni) Terlecki; daughter, Sara A. Terlecki of Unionville, CT; brother, J. Darrell (LaNelle) Warren; sister, Deborah K. (James) Mullins of Morrilton, AR; five nephews, two nieces, and several great-nieces and -nephews.
