Roy Hickman Jr., 82, of Hot Springs passed away Thursday October 10, 2013. He was born May 19, 1931 to the late Henrietta Smith Hickman and Ira Hickman in Alpine, Arkansas.

Roy graduated from American River College in Sacramento, California. He retired from 223rd CMC Air Guard serving during the Korean Conflict; retired from Arkansas Soil and Water Commission; a member Hot Springs Masonic Lodge #62; he was an ordained deacon and a member of Grand Avenue Baptist Church and he was the first Mayor of Fountain Lake in 1999. He was predeceased by his parents; one brother, Jimmy Hickman and one sister, Joan Griffin.
