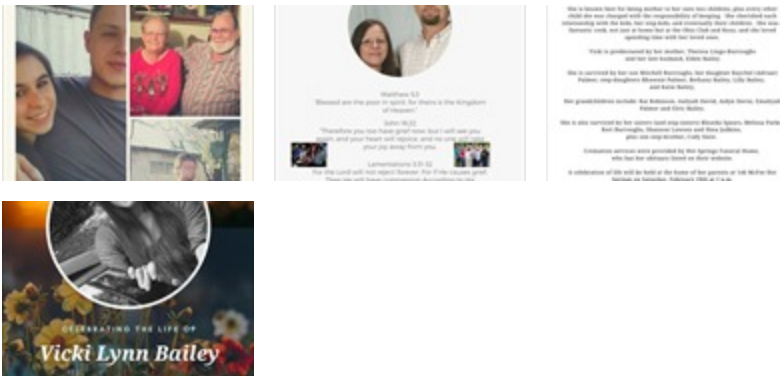

Your stepmother has done the best she could do

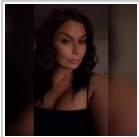
And no matter your age, she'll always love you
