Walter Howard Thrasher Jr passed on into the hands of our Lord, October 15, 2024 in Hot Springs, Ar.

Better known as "SKYMAN" by his Military friends, family, and other organizations. Walter Thrasher was born August 16, 1944 in Dayton, Ohio. He grew up in a Military environment inspired by his father which lead to a life of extensive travel before settling down in Pearcy, Ar. Walt graduated at the age of 17 from Lake Hamilton High School in 1962. He immediately enlisted into the United States Air Force serving 2 tours in Vietnam. As a decorated Veteran, he gave 38 distinguished years to his Military career to "Protect Our Country and Our Freedom". Skyman had an extensive passion as a pilot for flying, riding motorcycles, and enjoying life where ever it lead him. He was very dedicated to the VVO, VFW, and The American Legion, amongst many other organizations. In the later years of his life, he enjoyed time with his family and friends here in Arkansas.

He is survived by sister, Patricia Juanita Weaver (Ron); two sons, Bill Thrasher (Stephanie) from Versailles, Ky. and Trey Thrasher from Hot Springs, Ar.; several grandchildren, nieces, and nephews.
