William "Photo Billy" Andhor, 77, of Hot Springs, Arkansas passed away, Thursday, June 2, 2022. He was born June 20, 1944 in Buffalo, New York.

He was predeceased by his father, William Andhor; brother, Charles "Corky" Andhor.

William joined the Elks Lodge #380 in 2003 because all his friends in Hot Springs and at Oaklawn were Elks. He liked the work they did for the community like Thanksgiving and Christmas baskets and for the veterans. He volunteered for the kitchen and helped when they needed it. He would help Mike Muldoon with ordering food for the week and pick up fresh vegetables from local produce stores. He had his own crew for fish fry's and special events and helped John Junkerman & Pam McDaniel in the kitchen. He was Elk of the year 2012-2013 and outstanding service commendation 2014-2015.

He worked photo finish cameras at Oaklawn for 15 years and retired in 2011. The photo finish camera would photograph the finish at the wire of the race and show the placing judges the order of finish, first, second, thirds. He

worked 32 race tracks in 27 cities in 10 states.

William was a valuable & loyal volunteer for the Humane Society of Garland County and will be dearly missed.

He is survived by his mother, Mary Andhor; brother, John (Collen) Andhor and sister, Elizabeth Andhor and many nieces & nephews.
